JORDAN NATIONAL KARTING REGULATIONS – JNKR

The Jordan National Karting Regulations are governed by the 2008 CIK/FIA International Karting Regulations and Championship Regulations unless stated otherwise in the Supplementary Regulations.

TERMINOLOGY AND DEFINITIONS

CIK Commission Internationale De Karting (World Karting Federation)

FIA Federation International de l' Automobile

ASN Jordan Motor Sport (JMS) delegated and authorized by the Royal Automobile Club of Jordan (RACJ), the holder of the sporting power in the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan (HKJ).

RD Race Director

SM Stewards of the meeting

JNKR Jordan National Karting Regulations.

AKC Autonomous Karting Commission delegated the authority of the ASN for Karting matters.

The supplementary regulations for JNKR are established by the AKC having particular regulations based on the technical and economical criteria particular to the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan.

JORDAN KARTING CHAMPIONSHIP (JKC)

RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Jordan Karting Championship (JKC) is governed by the Jordan National Karting Regulations (JNKR) and shall be based on the FMK group 2, Intercontinental A class (ICA) and the following JKC supplementary regulations.

EVENT OFFICIALS

Event officials will be announced in the Supplementary Regulations of each race.

CHAMPIONSHIP

The championship calendar is shown in appendix 3 and JMS shall announce any changes to the calendar on notice board.

The Championship shall constitute of the total points accumulated by any driver from participating in all the events of the year.

The FMK Intercontinental-A (ICA) rules and regulations shall generally be applied unless stated otherwise in the Supplementary Regulations.

Participation is open to Jordanian nationals and non-Jordanian residents holding a valid Karting license issued by JMS and passing the driving and regulation test arranged by the AKC, with a minimum age of 14 (1995 born are accepted) years old.

Drivers between the age of 14-18 who passed the test and approved by AKC and have their indemnity form signed by one of his/her parents at JMS offices will be permitted to race.

Specific information for any of the events shall be posted at the JMS notice board no later than 48 hours prior to the start of the event.

An Entry Form for participation in any event must be submitted no later than 72 hours prior to the timed session of the event accompanied by the entry fees.

Late entry applications will be accepted 48 hours before the race with double entry fees.

Cancellation of participation in any event must be submitted at least 24 hours prior to the timed session of the event.

The races shall be held as follows:

Friday: Timed Session

Qualifying Heats

Final Race

Note: Drivers' briefings are mandatory and must be attended by all entrants under the penalty of possible exclusion from the race.

TIMED SESSION

All karts must run seven laps; one warm-up lap followed by six timed laps in order to decide the starting position for all the qualifying heats.

RACE

All karts shall compete in heats. The total points scored in the heats shall determine the top 15 karts to qualify for the final race, along with their respective grid positions.

The heats shall consist of 15 laps each and 20 laps for the final race.

The Stewards of the Meeting has the right to change the number of laps at their discretion, the drivers will be notified before the start of the session.

WEIGHT

Minimum weight of Kart and Driver shall be 145 kg.

POINTS

The following points system will be adopted for 2008 Championship:

- a) Points will be awarded for top 10 finishers as follows 12,10,8,7,6,5,4,3,2,1
- b) In addition to the above points, classification according to classes will also be awarded points as follows 10,9,8,7,6,5,4,3,2,1.

In calculating championship points both points in paragraphs (a) and (b) above will be added for all the races on the attached calendar.

Example:

Overall winner is driving a Class A Kart, points awarded will be:

$$12 + 10 = 22 \text{ points}$$

2nd overall is driving a Class B Kart:

$$10 + 10 = 20 \text{ points}$$

3rd overall is driving a Class A Kart

8 + 9 = 17 points

HEATS AND GROUPS

- 0 Up to 20 karts: all karts shall compete in three heats. The top 15 shall qualify for the final
- 21 to 40 karts: Karts shall be divided into two groups, each group shall compete in two heats, top 15 karts shall qualify for the final.

TRACK RULES

- The track used for this championship shall be announced 48 hours prior to each event
- The track practice hours shall be posted at the RACJ bulletin board.

TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

All competitors must comply with all technical regulations. The following technical regulations shall apply:

CLASS A – WATER COOLED

- Water cooled ICA karts with valid homologated documents. Driver must submit homologation documents before importing the Kart for approval.
- Recently approved and homologated chassis and engines are approved and are subject to scrutineering at anytime.
- Tyre choice will be open.
- The AKC reserves the rights to amend any part of the championship regulations, postpone, cancel, or add events, as it deems necessary.

CLASS B – AIR COOLED

Two engines shall be allowed of the following models:

- Dino 508 or 518, CRG S10-T1 Reed ICA engine. Both engines shall be of same make.
- One Dino 497/498 Chassis or CRG Kalifornia shall be allowed.

Additionally recently approved and homologated chassis and engines are approved and are subject to scrutineering at anytime.

Scrutineering shall be held before the timed practice, before the qualifying heats and after the final.

The Race Director and/or The Stewards shall order the scrutineering of all or any of the first five winners in the final and/or any other kart in the event.

Reminder: The karts are not allowed to leave the Parc Fermé unless permitted to do so by the Race Director under the penalty of exclusion from the event.

WARNINGS AND PENALTIES

Any driver who does not comply with all safety regulations, disciplines, track rules, championship regulations and any regulations or instructions of the officials and marshals of the meeting, shall inflict upon himself penalties that can lead to fines, exclusion from events and suspension of license.

Offenders will be issued warnings as follows:

- Verbal warning
- Written warning with penalty

Penalties include but are not limited to:

- Penalty points during heats
- Starting a race at the back of the grid
- Deduction or cancellation of championship points
- Disqualification from races
- Suspension of license
- Fines

The above mentioned guidelines will generally be followed and are subject to the Race Director & Stewards' discretion.

PROTESTS

Protests shall be submitted to the Race Director as in article 17 of the FMIK Championship regulations and must be accompanied by a 20.-JD protest fee.

The Stewards' decisions regarding protests are final.
